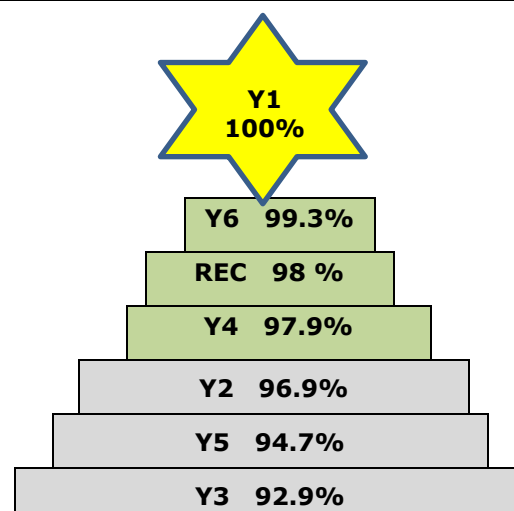
As a school we regularly liaise with the Cheshire police about this but we have no authority ourselves to move vehicles or instruct drivers.
