

SCIENCE Workshop Y6

As part of our extensive transition work, Year Six have worked closely with

Dr. Birchall from the Culcheth High science department. The children have investigated elements of the chemistry curriculum and received their first taste of the equipment on offer in the secondary phase. The week-long project started in Newchurch and introduced the children to new symbolism and resources as well as the importance of risk assessment. It continued at Culcheth High on Wednesday and Friday, where Year Six used Bunsen burners and various equipment to create drinkable water, then imagined they were farmers to test the chemicals using universal test strips.

Year Six demonstrated wonderful science knowledge throughout and showed that they are well-prepared for life in Key Stage Three. multiculturalism and started with a wide range of delicacies from around the world (which Year Six thoroughly enjoyed). The show then included Samba drumming, superb dance shows and an exhibition of Year Seven artwork. It was excellent to see so many former Newchurch pupils involved and presented with special awards at the end for their hard work and endeavour.


