YEAR 4 UPDATE

The Summer term is now well under way and the Year 4 children have been enjoying learning about new topics. Sound is the area of learning in science where the children have been using a range of musical instruments to identify how sounds are made and how they make their way into our ears. They also investigated the different types of sounds which can be heard from different areas of the school.

Through Topic lessons the children have been exploring the work of Antoni Gaudi, the famous Spanish architect. They have commented on his unusual style of design and are now working towards detailed sketches of his designs before using clay to make miniature models of buildings such as Sagrada Familia and Casa Batllo. Mr Singleton has been really impressed with the resilience of the children during this topic as they have taken real pride in their sketching and have been happy to make changes to further improve their artwork.
