



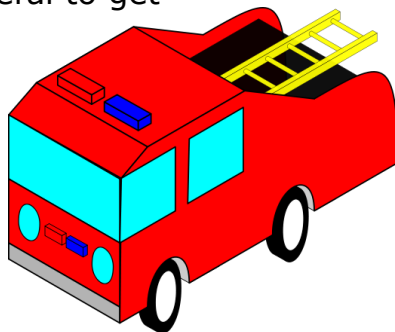
# FRIDAY NEWCHURCH

## TEAM 2 UPDATE

Since our Inset in September, we have introduced Talk4Writing. This involves the oral rehearsal of texts and then the children innovating on them by changing characters, settings and events. Already we are seeing a difference in the quality of the children's writing.

As part of our School Development Plan, Geography is a main focus and as such we have worked with Chris Trevor, a History and Geography consultant. She has provided INSET for staff on historical enquiry and ways of making geography exciting and hands on. Through our pupil conferencing, we can see the impact of the INSET on the children's perception of these subjects.

We have some exciting projects ahead of us, as in the Spring term we are focusing on the texts: the Queen's Handbag and The Queen's Hat as a stimulus for our Geography linked Book week.

## E-SAFETY FOCUS

On Tuesday, Mrs Sizer and two children from year 5 were selected to attend an E-safety meeting at Walton Hall. They spent the day learning about the importance of keeping safe online. The children have now become E-Safety Officers for the school, which is a very important role in helping us to keep safe online.

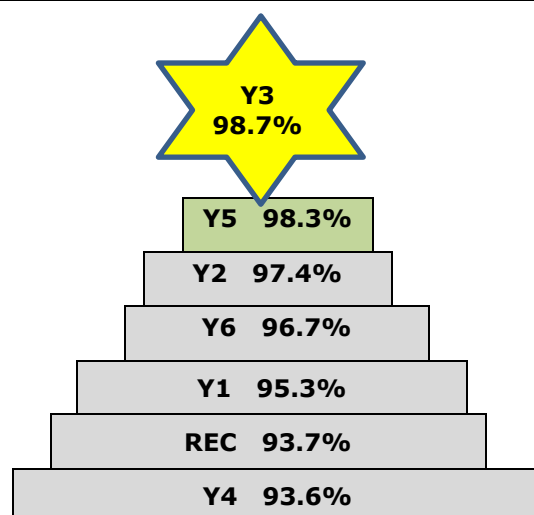
