

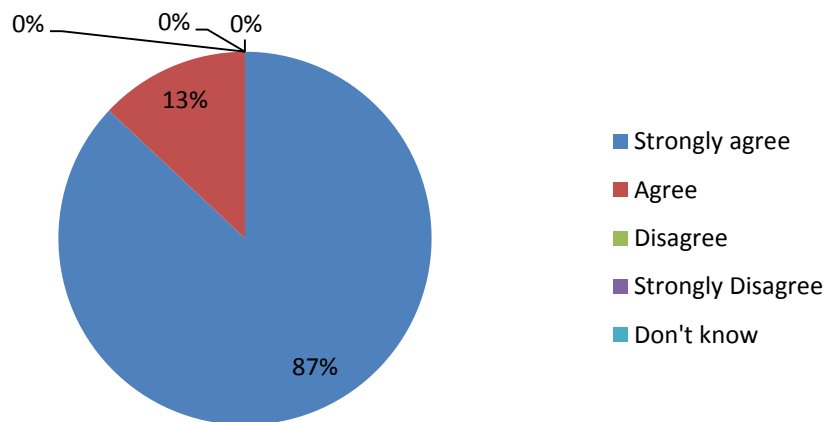

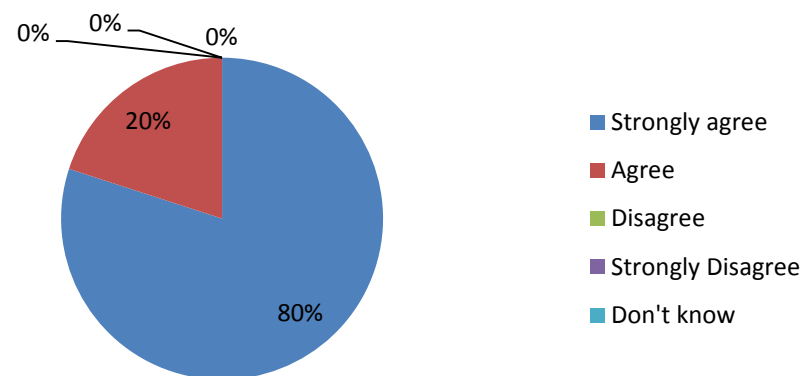
At the parents' evening in November, parents/carers were asked to complete a questionnaire about their views on our school. Please find below the extremely positive results.

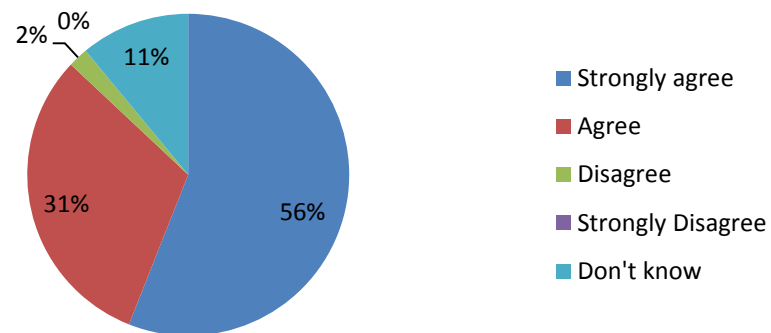
This school helps my child to develop skills in communication, reading, writing and mathematics



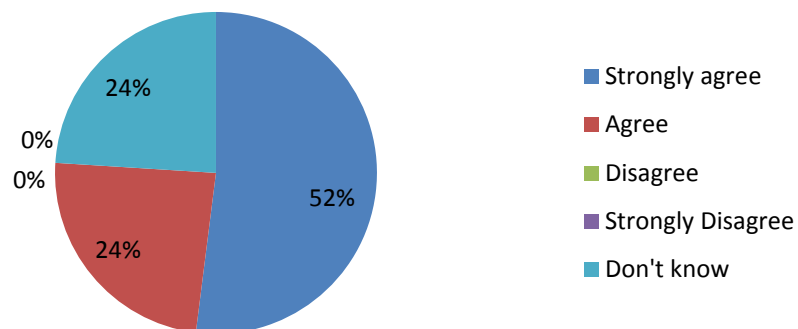
There is a good standard of behaviour at this school



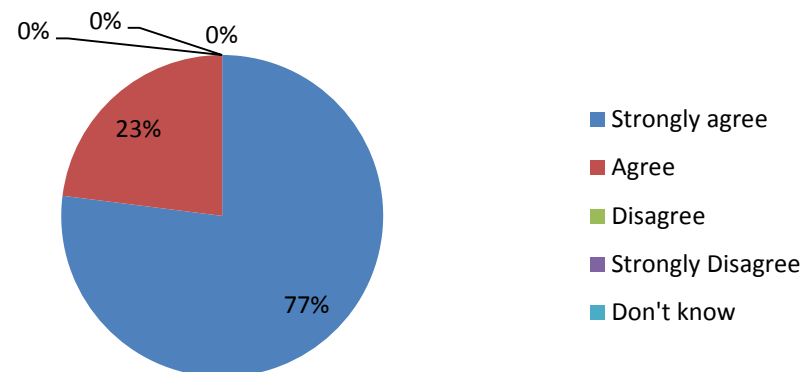
