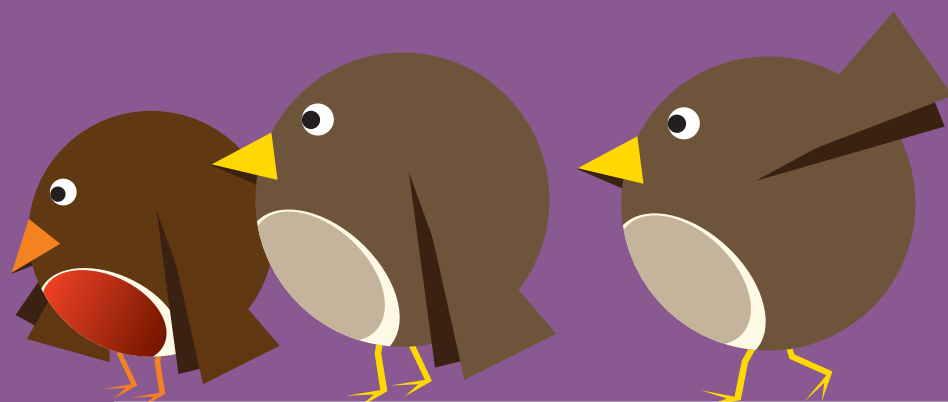
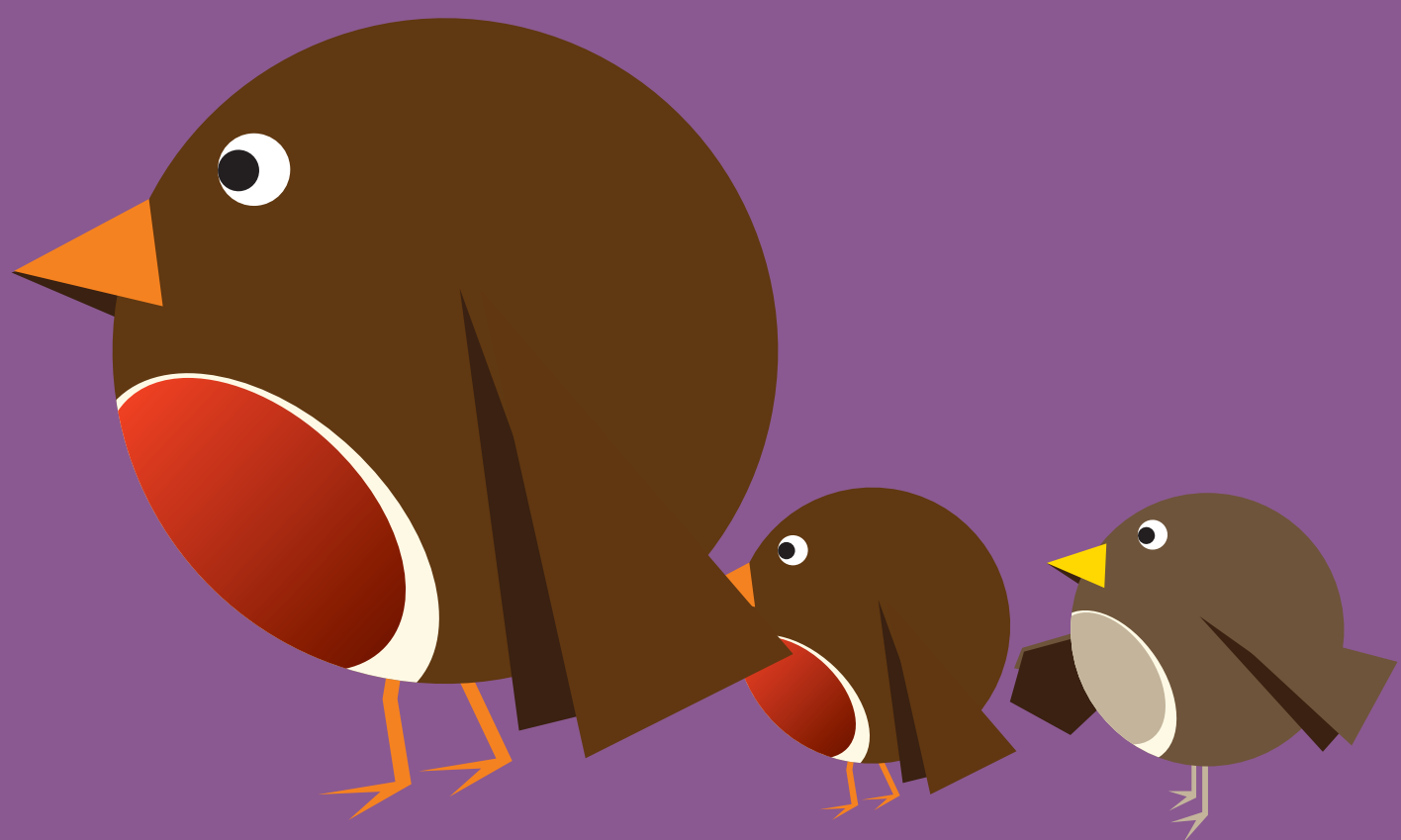

Teaching Children Responsible Behaviour will help our children to:

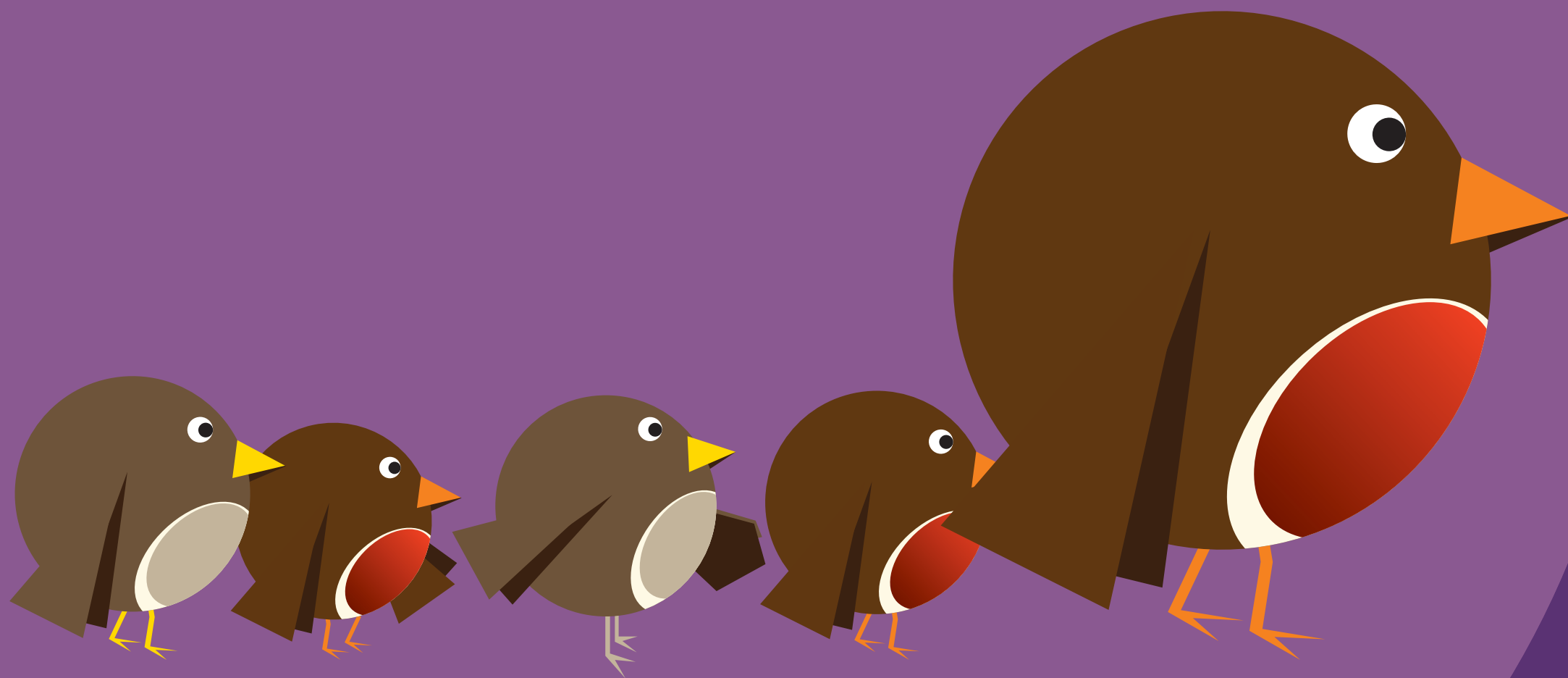
- **learn that their choices and actions have consequences;**

Teaching children responsibility is one of the schools key values. In order for this value to be developed in our pupils we will:

- 1. create an environment where responsibility is an expectation**
- 2. become role models for the children in the area of responsibility**
- 3. teach children to be responsible for their own actions**
- 4. let the children know that responsibility is the norm**
- 5. reinforce any responsible behaviours with praise**
- 6. provide consequences for irresponsible behaviour to deter any future episodes**



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
