




# Year 2 - Biodiversity Detectives

<b>What Is Biodiversity?</b>	<p>Task: Write a short explanation of what biodiversity means. Add drawings or cut-out pictures of at least 6 different living things (plants, insects, animals, etc).</p>	
<b>Local Wildlife Study</b>	<p>Task: Go outside (garden, park, or street) and record what you see. Make a wildlife tally chart of things like:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Birds</li><li>• Bugs</li><li>• Flowers</li><li>• Trees</li></ul> <p>Draw or list at least 5 living things and write one interesting thing about each.</p>	
<b>Make a mini habitat</b>	<p>Task: Create something that helps wildlife:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• A bug hotel</li><li>• A bird feeder</li><li>• A log pile or leaf shelter</li></ul> <p>Take a photo or draw it. then rite 2–3 sentences about:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• What you made</li><li>• Who it is for</li><li>• What you hope will happen</li></ul>	
<b>Amazing animals around the world</b>	<p>Task: Choose a wild animal from another country. Make a mini poster or fact file with:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• A drawing</li><li>• Where it lives</li><li>• What it eats</li><li>• A fun or unusual fact</li></ul>	
<b>Nature inspired art or poetry</b>	<p>Task: Choose one:</p> <p>Make a nature picture using leaves, petals or natural materials</p> <p>Write a poem or acrostic about an animal or nature (e.g. B-I-R-D)</p> <p>Paint or draw a beautiful scene full of plants and animals</p>	
<b>Celebrate your work</b>	<p>Task: Put all your work together into a Biodiversity Journal (or folder). Decorate the front cover and give it a title (e.g. "Our Wild World", "Nature Explorers"). Write a biodiversity promise at the end: "I will help nature by..."</p>
