GDPR UPDATE

As you may be aware there is a new data protection law that comes into effect today (25th May 2018). In order to achieve our mission statement of preparing to fly, we need to work in partnership with parents, pupils, governors, the Local Authority and carefully selected outside agencies. We are the Data Controller for the purposes of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and the personal data we hold is used to support teaching and learning. We have created a new section on our website called Data Protection and you will find our Data Protection Policy, parent, staff and pupil privacy notices for more information. We will be complying with the new changes to law and therefore you may receive letters relating to the data we hold for your family. THE COLLABORATIVE LEARNING GROUP

As you know, as a maintained WBC primary school, we work very closely with many other primary schools in the local authority to establish common best practice and support school development. Traditionally this has been done at least initially in geographical clusters e.g. Warrington East. More recently we have been seeking to work collaboratively with schools in different contexts to ours from different parts of Warrington to provide greater diversity and maximise the potential for peer to peer support and effective strategic leadership. We are currently working very closely with the following schools: Appleton Thorn, Cobbs, Grappenhall Heys, Broomfields, Locking Stumps, Meadowside, Dallam, Stockton Heath, Brook Acre. We are working together under the name 'The Collaborative Learning Group' and, although it is early in its inception, we are already seeing the huge potential this work has for improving teaching and learning and outcomes for our children and for driving strategic development. We hope parents/carers and, most importantly, the children will see the many positives that come from working collegiately in this way over the coming months. This collaborative group is by no means exclusive and does not prevent us working with any other WBC schools should the need arise – this is established common practice anyway.


