Year 6 Crucial Crew, Army Reserve Centre Monday 27th November 2023

After the success of previous years, we are delighted to once again be working in partnership with Crucial Crew to offer your child an exciting opportunity to take part in the Crucial Crew safety event.

Crucial Crew is a multi-agency safety event aimed at Year 6 children (10 to 11 year olds) designed to provide children with life skills that will enable them to keep themselves and others safe. It is generally accepted that children start to become more independent at this age and are often expected to cope increasingly on their own and deal with changes in their lives, such as a move to Secondary school. The aim of our Crucial Crew event is to raise each participant's awareness of threats and dangers, in a fun and interactive way.
