Reading:

Lost and Found – Oliver Jeffers



Our class text is **Lost and Found** by **Oliver Jeffers**. The story follows a boy who one day finds a penguin on his doorstep. The boy sets out on a journey to return the penguin to its home but discovers that home wasn't what the penguin was looking for after all.

We will write our own **adventure story** based on the book.

Writing:

We will be using our class text to focus on the following targets in our grammar and writing:

- Compose a sentence orally before writing it
- Sequence sentences to form short narratives
- Leave spaces between words
- Discuss what they have written with adults and peers
- Use capital letters for the names of people and the personal pronoun 'I'

Mathematics:

Along with our arithmetic and calculation skills we will be looking at the following areas of the curriculum:

We will be looking to master a wide range of targets linked to these areas, such as:

- Counting to 100, forwards and backwards
- Reading and writing numbers to 100 in numerals
- Finding 1 more and 1 less than a number
- Representing numbers using objects and pictures
- Comparing and ordering numbers
- Exploring the part-whole model
- Number bonds to 10
- Adding together
- Subtracting by taking away and crossing out

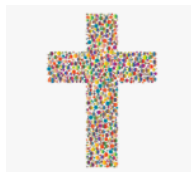
Physical Education:

Religious Education:



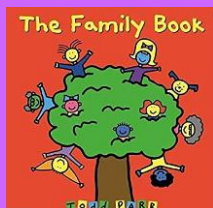
Christianity
