WarrPAC are officially launching the Warrington Annual SEND Survey 2025. To get the best outcomes for our children and young people and to ensure your combined voices are heard, we need everyone who has lived experiences of Education, Health and Social Care over the last 12 months to contribute.

We want to know what's working well and which areas are in need of improvement.

Why should I respond to this survey

All the feedback received in this survey is fed back and used by the Local Authority and Health to shape Warrington's SEND improvement plan.

It will also highlight areas for coproduction opportunities with professional teams to exact change moving forward. Although this is our parent/carer survey, we asked Education, Health and Social Care professionals to highlight any areas they wanted specific feedback on within the survey that would help them in acknowledging that there is still a huge amount of work to be done alongside a commitment to listen to your views and create the change we need.

Who should answer this survey?

Parents/carers of children and young people (0-25) with SEND (whether diagnosed or not) who live within Warrington Borough, or who access services across Education, Health and Social Care in Warrington.

What happens to the information in the survey?

Firstly, this survey is anonymous therefore please do not include any information that identifies individuals.

When all the data has been collected, analysed and summarised, WarrPAC will produce a report which we will share with the Local Authority, Health and of course all our Parents and Carers.

It is this survey that paves the way in respect of holding the Local Authority and Health Professionals accountable, challenging them to prioritise the things that are most important and have the most impact on you and your child / young person.

The more voices we obtain, the more impact we can make

More voices, more opinions, more constructive views only serves to strengthen our position when it comes to challenging decision makers on what is impacting our children and young people with SEND.

We also need to protect the good stuff that's already in place so we don't lose it in the future, so please tell us about what is working well.

We all know its easy to overlook just one voice but as a collective we are more likely to be heard.

We need to challenge systemic barriers and influence the quality and availability of SEND services in Warrington. We can do this better with you than without you.
