Any Other Business

Secretary Handover from Helen Buckley

Vicky has come straight from a meeting with Helen Buckley where they have been carrying out a Secretary Handover. Helen explained that there were a number of forms / documents that may well be out of date: for example the Insurance, Charity Commission and the Small Society Lottery Licence. It was decided that we need to get some of the PTA together to have a look at all the official documentation that is required and make sure it's up to date.

CO-OP Projects Together - Arts Mark

Helen Buckley notified us of a Co-Op project called Project Together. They are looking for school projects to support and sponsor. Mr Duckett mentioned that the school "Art Mark" make fit the criteria. The details needed to be submitted by 8th April 2018.

PTA Money Spend

The PTA has £8k in the bank. We would like ideas as to what the kids would like us to support this year. Mr Duckett will ask the school council as to what they want. Interactive boards for Key Stage 1 are one requirement. A donation was made towards the new scooter park.

Prom PTA Support

Year 6 have asked for a monetary donation to help towards the Prom. Tickets are currently on sale at £25.00 which includes DJ, Limo and Food. It was asked that the PTA offer to fund a part of the Prom. It was discussed and decided that what the PTA will support the Prom every year going forward by donating £10 per child to fund the ticket price. Ticket prices must remain the same (approx. £25 per head), and the £10 is to be used to reduce the ticket price only. Must not be added to the ticket price!!!. This helps parents as it isn't a cheap event.
