Dear Parent/Carer,

We are delighted to inform you that we are finalising a two-day residential educational adventure activity course at the Kingswood Centre at Colomendy, Denbighshire in April 2025 for Year 4. We are very fortunate to have secured a booking as it is extremely popular with school groups.

Kingswood is the leading residential activity centre provider, welcoming over 130,000 children each year. Their centres provide a rewarding educational programme offering many curriculum-linked modules combined with thrilling outdoor and indoor adventure activities, with secure and controlled residential accommodation.

The trip will take place from **Wednesday 23<sup>rd</sup> April to Friday 25<sup>th</sup> April**. The cost of the visit will be **£194**. The trip includes return travel by coach, full board, accommodation, insurance and a full programme of activities. This price includes a small reduction based on their class enterprise event.

Payments can be made in instalments as follows with the final balance due by the end May 2025.

Should you prefer to pay earlier or all at once, that is absolutely fine. Equally, if you would like to pay off a little each week that can also be arranged.
