English Our class texts for this half term:




Writing:

We will be using our class text to focus on the following targets in our grammar and writing:

- Compose a sentence orally before writing it
- Combine words to make sentences
- Sequence sentences to form short narratives
- Leave spaces between words
- Discuss what they have written with adults and peers
- Re-read what they have written to check it makes sense
- Use capital letters for the names of people and the personal pronoun 'l'
- Begin to use capital letters and full stops

Mathematics:

Along with our arithmetic and calculation skills we will be looking at the following areas of the curriculum:



We will be looking to master a wide range of targets linked to these areas, such as:

- Counting forwards and backwards within 10
- One more and one less than a given number
- Sorting, counting, identifying and representing using objects and representations numbers within 10
- Understanding one-to-one correspondence
- Using number lines and equal to, more than and less than
- Reading and writing numbers within 10 in numerals
- Reading, writing and interpreting addition and subtraction calculations including =
- Representing and using number bonds and related number facts within 10
- Adding and subtracting one-digit numbers
- Solving addition and subtraction problems using concrete objects and visual representations – including missing number problems

Science:

Our scientific studies will focus on **Seasonal Changes.** We will be exploring the four seasons and the key events and changes that occur in each one. We will focus on Autumn and Winter, in particular, and compare different trees, observing how they change across the seasons.

We will observe and describe weather associated with the seasons and how day length varies. We will look at different types of weather in each season and perform simple tests to investigate weather that we experience.

The children will work like historians to find out about toys from the past and explore similarities and differences. They will create timelines, build family trees and uses various sources of information.
