Make a home for nature	<p>Task: With help from an adult, create something that helps wildlife:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A bug hotel A simple bird feeder A pile of leaves or stones for insects <p>Draw or take a photo of what you made. Label it: "I made a ___ for ___."</p>
My favourite wild animal	<p>Task: Choose a wild animal you like.</p> <p>Make a fact sheet or information poster with:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A drawing or picture Where it lives One amazing fact <p>🖋️ Example: "A giraffe has a long neck. It eats leaves."</p>
Nature Art	<p>Task: Make a picture using things from nature—leaves, sticks, petals, or stones.</p> <p>You can:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Make a leaf animal Do a bark rubbing Create a pattern with stones Bring it in or take a photo to share.
