
Newchurch Community Primary School - Share in our learning...Year 1 Spring A


Writing:

We will be using our class text to focus on the following targets in our grammar and writing:

- Compose a sentence orally before writing it
- Combine words to make sentences
- Sequence sentences to form short narratives
- Discuss what they have written with adults and peers
- Re-read what they have written to check it makes sense
- Use capital letters for the names of people and the personal pronoun 'I'
- Begin to use capital letters and full stops
- Join words using 'and'
- Use plural noun suffixes -s and -es

Mathematics:

Along with our arithmetic and calculation skills we will be looking at the following areas of the curriculum:



We will be looking to master a wide range of targets linked to these areas, such as:

- Adding by counting on
- Finding and making number bonds
- Adding by making 10
- Subtracting crossing 10
- Counting, comparing and ordering numbers within 50

Our scientific studies will focus on **Animals**.

We will be identifying and comparing different animal groups – fish, amphibians, reptiles, mammals and birds.

will look at the terms carnivore, herbivore and omnivore and group animals according to what they eat.

We will be exploring a variety of balances and different ways to travel.

We will explore how to adapt movements

to match different music and practise creating a sequence of movements before performing and evaluating the routines.
