Dear Parent/Carer,

As the festive season rapidly approaches, our Newchurch Robins (big and small) are all very excited. Every day, you can hear children practising their Christmas play songs and excitedly walking into the hall to perform their dances on the stage. Newchurch is truly a magical place to be all year round but more so at Christmas time. However, the school also recognises that the diversity of our Newchurch Family extends beyond Christianity and therefore we will be looking to raise awareness of the similarities and differences between religious celebrations.

Christmas Plays

Everyone's highlight of the festive period is the chance to watch our Newchurch Robins in the Christmas productions. They are truly delightful and so everyone wants to watch them, but they do cause some difficulties for schools with regards to the number of people who can be in the audience at one time, as we must comply with fire safety regulations.

Once again, the Christmas plays will be ticketed events, with a different coloured ticket for each performance. We need to take into account the number of children in the hall **plus** the spectating adults. We would love nothing more than to invite everyone but we are sure you understand that safety comes first, as is the need to treat everyone equally.

Tickets will be sent home with your child on **Monday 24**th **November**. **Each child** will receive **one ticket** per performance (two tickets in total). This means that there will be a chance for all children to have at least one person in the audience. The distribution of tickets will look different depending on the classes your children are in. For example:

- If you have a child in KS1 and one in KS2, you will receive two tickets for KS1 (one for each performance) and two tickets for KS2 (one for each performance)
- If you have two children in KS1, then you will receive four tickets (two for each performance). This is the same for KS2.





























- If you have twins, each child will still receive their allocation.
- If you have three children in one key stage, you will receive six tickets (three for each performance).

We recognise that some parents work, or are unable to make some of the performances, and should families wish to swap them amongst themselves, this is absolutely no problem. As long as you have the right coloured ticket for the performance you are attending, there will be no issue.

In the past, some people have come to school for the performance but say they have forgotten their ticket or have the wrong colour. We recognise that this can happen; however, please appreciate that organising these events requires military precision and a firm eye on the safety of the children and attendees. If you do not have your ticket on the day, you will be asked to wait until all those with tickets have been seated and if there are spaces available, you will be allowed admittance.

Unfortunately, in the past we have had occasions when someone has forgotten their ticket and when we have asked for them to wait, they have been rude to members of staff who are following the guidance given to them. Just a reminder that respectful behaviour is always expected when entering Newchurch so please be mindful of this. Could we ask that you inform any family members who will be attending of these rules and to avoid this even happening, please just remember to bring your tickets.

For families where parents do not live together, we recognise that there is an extended family who hold special places in the children's hearts. We will hold some extra tickets in reserve and allocate one extra ticket. Please just come to the office (or email school) and speak with Michelle or Rachel and they will be happy to help.

Younger children do not need a ticket but will need to sit on an adult's knee. If you have any tickets you do not need, please give them to the school office so they can be redistributed. If you require additional tickets, please speak to the office and they will put you on a waiting list. Please be aware that we cannot guarantee additional tickets.

We recognise also that Year 2 and Year 4 children have the lead parts in the Christmas plays. As we do with our Year 6 parents at the end of the year, the first four rows of chairs will be reserved for parents of these two classes.

Pre-loved Christmas Jumpers and Winter Coats



As we approach the festive season, there will be lots of additional expense and we would like to try to keep the festive fun alive but be considerate of our families. On **Wednesday 17**th **December,** we will have our annual Christmas Dinner, Party and Jumper Day. Christmas jumpers are seasonal and quite expensive so we would

like to set up a Christmas jumper swap if possible. If you have any children's Christmas jumpers that are in good condition, but have been outgrown, please could you send them into school on **Wednesday**



























26th **November**. We will then set up a stall outside school on **Thursday 27**th **November** after school until 5:30pm so children who need a Christmas jumper can take one.

In addition to the Christmas jumpers, if you have any spare winter coats you would like to donate, please feel free to drop them into the office on the above dates. Many thanks in anticipation of your continued and valued support.

Dress Down Day

Just a reminder that **Monday 24th November** is dress down day for any donations for the Christmas Fair (KS1 – sweetie jars and KS2 – bottles for tombola prizes). The PTA would also like any donations of teddies also for a teddy stall. Please ensure that they are clean and in good condition. If you are able to contribute, the PTA will be available to collect your donations on the school carpark in the morning. Any children who come into Robins in the morning can bring them into school and we will ensure they are passed on to the PTA.
