Dear Parent/Carer,

In the last few weeks, we have been reviewing our communication with parents regarding the experiences the children have both inside and outside of school.

When your child started in Reception, they were provided with a 'Home-School' book which is aimed at developing the children's ability to form positive relationships with their peers and the adults in their classroom whilst also supporting the development of effective communication and language. Now that restrictions have been lifted, we would very much like to reinstate the movement of this book backwards and forwards between home and school. You can include anything in the book: photographs, menus of places you have eaten out, pictures the children have drawn etc.

In addition to this, we would like you to be more involved in sharing in your child's learning and evidence towards the early learning goals across the curriculum in order to support your child in achieving a Good Level of Development.

The school uses 2Simple Evidence Me as a means to recording observations of significant learning across the curriculum but also to capture your child's interests and next steps on their learning journey.

You will have received a Parent Share invitation to activate your account using the email address we have on file when your child started school. All you need to do is click on the link to activate and confirm your email address.
