Classes for next year

As you are aware, we welcomed Mrs Brinksman-Wood back from her maternity leave and she is now working part-time, job-sharing with Mrs Toone. We are also delighted to announce that Mrs Parkinson, our Year 4 teacher, is due to return from her maternity leave at the end of June and will support a number of classes until she resumes her class teacher role in September. We would very much like to thank Miss Denniston for all her hard work and commitment to Newchurch this academic year whilst she covered Mrs Parkinson's maternity leave, and wish her all the best for the future.

Mr Hughes will be leaving us at the end of the school year to pursue a career in secondary education. We are sure you join us in wishing him well and thanking him for his commitment to Newchurch over the two years he has been with us.

Following the news of Mr Hughes and after a recent recruitment drive, we are pleased to welcome Miss Megan Lunn as a permanent teacher to join the Newchurch Team from September 2025. As a result of this recruitment, we are now able to share our staffing structure for the next academic year. The reasoning behind such early communication is to ensure effective transition for <u>all</u> our children between now and September, enabling the children to form positive relationships with their new teacher and teaching assistant prior to the start of the school year.

When making decisions around staffing each year, there are many factors that need to be taken into consideration: the needs of each cohort, the journey each class has had whilst at Newchurch as well as the professional development of staff. We have been working on our structure since February (with many drafts made) and feel that we are now in a place to share this with you. The staffing structure for 2025-2026 will be:

Transition arrangements

We have always boasted an effective transition for our pre-school children into reception and wanted to replicate this if possible for all our children as they move into their next year group, or indeed prepare to fly onto high school. We have looked at the transition arrangements for the children into the next academic year and have decided to have staggered approach.

The children will start by being taught in their own classrooms, with their current teaching assistants, and their teacher will join them. In the penultimate week, when the children will have had a number of sessions to form relationships with their adults, the children will spend time in their new classroom with their new teacher and teaching assistants. Our Year 6 children will spend time focusing on their end of year performance but also engaging in some transition activities with their receiving high school – please diary of dates.

The dates of transition for the **<u>current</u>** Reception – Year 5 classes are as such:

- Thursday 19th June playtime and story time transition
- Monday 23rd June morning transition
- Wednesday 2nd July full day transition
- Wednesday 16th and 17th July full day transition (new classroom)

We have secured Miss Lunn to visit Newchurch to have some of the transition days with the current Year 4 but unfortunately, due to her commitments to her current school, she will not be able to visit us on all the days. She will be joining us on 16th and 17th July.

Please be aware that it is perfectly normal for all children to find the idea of change challenging, but we will do all we can to make it as seamless as possible. This transition model itself is a development from last year and more than many schools offer so hopefully it will help settle the children.

Prior to the transition sessions, staff will meet to share information about every child, children will be provided with social stories to support the transition and additional informal visits to their new classroom for children with additional needs will be facilitated.
