Newchurch Robins Wraparound Care

There have been some recent changes in Newchurch Robins with the introduction of a hot option for breakfast and sometimes after school. The children are now sitting down to eat breakfast together before they go to their classes. It is lovely to see as the older ones are brilliant with the younger children.

There has also been a lot of creative planning going on over the last few months with regards to the provision for our children who attend Newchurch Robins before and after school. We wanted to do something a little bit different!

We have consulted with the children regarding the different things they would like to do when they are in Newchurch Robins, thinking about how we can cater for all ages and interests of those who attend.

March will see the development of the space and the linked resources. This will include the zoning of spaces to create bases which include:

- Creative area
- Role play (changing theme regularly)
- Construction
- Board games and puzzles
- Gaming space
- Chill out area
- Reading Corner
- LEGO table
- Mindfulness table



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Enrichment Activities

Starting in April, there will be monthly themed activities for the children to engage in which will be linked to a children's film. These activities will develop over the course of the month to meet the children's interests and to maintain their enthusiasm and engagement.

For example, Mary Poppins will be the theme for April and this will include activities such as:

- Making different kinds of kites
- Making bird feeders
- Making origami birds and mobiles
- Creating masterpieces with chalk

As the month comes to an end, the children will have a movie night on the Friday complete with tickets, ice creams and popcorn. Obviously, children who attend Robins on a Friday will be able to watch this, but we are opening this session up initially to any children who already regularly attend after school or breakfast club. You just simply book your onto the session. If this goes well, we will look to offering this out to other children.
