

Year 3 - Plant Life: Our Biodiversity Mission

What Is Biodiversity and Why Is It Important?	<p>Task: Write a short explanation of biodiversity (in your own words). Include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A definition • At least 3 reasons why biodiversity matters • Draw or describe examples of diverse living things
Local Habitat Hunt	<p>Task: Go outside and explore a local green space. Create a habitat map or mini field report:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Describe the type of habitat (e.g., woodland, park, pond) • List and sketch at least 5 living things • Describe one food chain you notice or imagine
Make a Wildlife Home	<p>Task: With adult support, build or design something to help local wildlife:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Bug hotel • Hedgehog shelter • Bird bath or feeder • Pollinator-friendly planter <p>Document it with a labelled diagram or photo along with a few sentences about what you built and how it helps biodiversity</p>
World Wildlife Research	<p>Task: Choose a plant or animal from a different part of the world (rainforest, desert, ocean, etc). Create a fact file including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Name and picture • Habitat and country • What it eats and who eats it • Any dangers it faces (e.g., habitat loss)
Biodiversity Through Art or Writing	<p>Choose ONE: Create a biodiversity-themed artwork (poster, painting, collage, sculpture) Write a short story or poem from the point of view of a plant or animal Prompt: "A Day in the Life of a Bumblebee" or "The Lonely Oak Tree"</p>
My Biodiversity Explorer's Logbook	<p>Task: Organise your 5 weeks of work into a logbook, journal, or presentation. Include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A contents page • Your favourite task and why • A final page: "How I Will Help Nature" (with 3 promises or actions)
