As some of you may remember, we sadly said goodbye to Alex Whitehouse, our PE Apprentice, who worked tirelessly last year to ensure the children were active and engaged in sporting activities to improve their health and wellbeing. However, we are delighted to welcome Nathan Booth, a new apprentice, who will work alongside classes and also deliver PE sessions and sporting activities across the whole school.

Attendance Matters

As a school we aim for at least 97% attendance from each child. Children cannot help being ill but here is something to think about...

Attendance statistics over one school year

4 days absent from school = 98%

10 days absent from school = 95%

4 weeks absent from school = 90%

5.5 weeks absent from school = 85%

7.5 weeks absent from school = 80%

If a child was to have poor attendance from Y2 to Y6, what would that work out as?

85%-90% = approximately <u>half a year</u> off school

80% = 38 weeks absent from school which equates to <u>one whole year</u> of school missed!

As we know that good attendance impacts on attainment, this week each child has pledged to be an 'Attendance HERO'.



The class at the top of the attendance ladder each week will receive 5 points. If a class achieves 100%, then 10 points are awarded. The class with the highest number of points at the end of the year will get to go on a special reward trip.
