### End of year arrangements for Year Six

Here is an outline of the end of year procedures we have planned:

<b>Monday 30<sup>th</sup> June (at 11:30am)</b>	<b>Loved One to Lunch</b> Due to the staffing issues within the council, we have not been able to have Loved Ones to Lunch this year but as this is our Year Six Robins, the kitchen are going to ensure they have theirs. Usually, we ask that just one loved on joins their child but as it is Year Six's final one, we would like to invite two parents/carers (or grandparents). A booking link will be sent to you.
<b>Monday 30<sup>th</sup> June and/or Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> July (all morning)</b>	<b>SEND visits to high school – CHS only</b> Children with special educational needs who would benefit from an additional pre-visit to their destination high school will visit the school for the morning. Parents of children who need a pre-visit will be contacted directly.
<b>Wednesday 3<sup>rd</sup> July and Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> July (all day)</b>	<b>Transition to High School Days</b> All Year Six will spend the days in their destination high schools. You should have received details of this. Some high schools may not have kept to the agreed plan for all Warrington schools and may only have one transition day.
<b>Tuesday 8<sup>th</sup> July</b>	<b>SATs Results Day</b> Schools will receive the results of the children's SATs on this day.



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<b>Friday 11<sup>th</sup> July</b>	<b>Year Six Enterprise Day</b> Please ensure the children are in PE kits as the children will be doing a sponsored row using the rowing machines. The monies gathered as a result of the enterprise goes towards the cost of something for the playground as a legacy for the cohort.
<b>Thursday 17<sup>th</sup> July</b>	<b>End of Year Production Dress Rehearsal (in school)</b> Year Six will perform their end of year production to the rest of the school. Please ensure all costumes are in school by this date.
<b>Monday 21<sup>st</sup> July</b>	<b>All day Rehearsal of end of year production</b> Please can all children be dropped off at Culcheth High School for 8:45am. Mr Singleton and Mrs Monks will meet you there.
<b>Tuesday 22<sup>nd</sup> July</b>	<b>9:00am – 10:30am Rehearsal of end of year production</b> Please can all children be dropped off at Culcheth High School at 8:45am. Mr Singleton and Mr Boon will meet the children there. <b>6pm Year Six End of Year Production and Award Ceremony</b> This will be held at Culcheth High School and all families of children in Year Six are welcome; up to 6 family members can attend. Children will need to be at Culcheth High School by 5:30pm.
<b>Thursday 24<sup>th</sup> July</b>	<b>Last Day at Newchurch</b> Children should be in full school uniform. They may bring in an extra shirt for their peers, staff and other children to sign. <b>2pm Leavers' Assembly</b> You are warmly welcome to join us for the last ever assembly your child will experience at Newchurch. As is customary, parents of Year 6 children will have the first three rows reserved for them. At the end of the school day, Year 6 will be held back a little so we can give them their individual goodbye from all the staff as they make their final walk along Newchurch Way!

We have had the opportunity to liaise with all the destination schools to ensure the transition is effective and I am sure that our Newchurch robins will thrive as they move into Year 7.
