Sports Days

Just a reminder that we will be holding our annual sports days later this month:

Monday 24 th July in the morning	Reception, Year 1 and Year 2

As usual, the children will be representing their house teams: Radcliffe, Risley, Culcheth and Holcroft – historical families of Culcheth. House points will be presented to children as part of the sports day activities. The winning house at the end of the year, after months of accumulating house points will have a special treat and be the team to be engraved on our new trophy. Each house will wear a particular colour:

Please ensure your child has a sun hat and water bottle that morning as well as their usual hoodie so they are ready for any type of weather.

There are no restrictions on numbers for the sports day but you may wish to bring along a chair so you can enjoy the morning in comfort. Younger siblings are more than welcome to join us as we usually have a toddlers' race at the end. Parents are welcome to also join in the parents' race at the end of sports day.



The side gate by Year Six will be opened at 9:15am for a 9:30am start and we ask that all visitors access the school field from this point.

It is hoped that the weather will be in our favour. Please keep your fingers crossed.

Year Six Production and Awards Evening

As I write this letter, I can hear Year Six singing their hearts out as they prepare for their end of year production on **Wednesday 19th July**. Year 5 have the chance to watch the dress rehearsal at the high school on Wednesday morning before Year Six perform to their families in the evening.

Please could we ask that the children arrive at the high school for 5pm and doors will open at 5:30pm. The performance is about 90 minutes and this will be followed by a beautiful awards ceremony which celebrates the unique qualities of every child in the class. Once again there are no restrictions on numbers. It does get rather hot so please bring some water with you and ensure your child has their water bottle too.

Summer Projects Exhibition

Children are asked to bring their summer homework projects into school on **Friday 21st July** and we would like to invite you at the end of the school day to come and see what they have produced. It always amazes us how diverse their ideas are.

The projects will remain in school so the children are able to do their presentations to their peers in small groups. This is to support the children's listening and speaking skills. Projects will then be sent home on **Monday 24th July**.

Books

On **Tuesday 25th July** the children's books will be sent home for you to share with your child and treasure for ever. Please ensure that your child has a labelled plastic bag on this day so they are able to transport them home.

Leavers' assembly

On **Wednesday 26th July at 2pm**, we will be having our annual Leavers' assembly when we take the time to celebrate the achievements of all our children, but especially our Year Six Newchurch robins as they prepare to fly to high school.

All classes will be performing on the stage and so we welcome parents or grandparents to join us for the occasion. In order to ensure that we adhere to the fire regulations, we ask that only **one person attends per child** for children in Reception through to Year Five. Year Six children may have two adults per child as this is their final assembly and leaving primary school is a rite of passage they would want to share with their loved ones. As is tradition, the first four rows of seats will be reserved for parents of Year Six pupils.

School will finish at the normal time on Wednesday.
