

Poetry: Apes to Zebras, An A to Z of Shape Poems




We will explore a variety of shape poems and focus on how language is used for effect. We will research information on giraffes before writing our own shape poem including language features such as alliteration, rhyme, similes






We will be consolidating learning of all of the topics we have explored and will also conduct some further enquires and investigations to expand our knowledge further.

Growing and changing and Keeping safe



This half term in PSHE, we will focus on a range of different topics including identifying that people are unique and respecting those differences by exploring the differences between male and female bodies.
