Changes to the school day

You may or may not recall a consultation earlier in the school year regarding the changes to the school day following guidance from the Department of Education. Many thanks to those parents who took the time to share their opinions and ideas regarding the length of the day as this enabled us to make an informed decision of the way forward.



At a meeting of the full governing body last week it was agreed that following the Easter holidays, the school day would be extended from 8:45am to 3:15pm for all pupils. In order to alleviate any parking and traffic issues, the class doors will be opening up from 8:40am and children will have a five minute window to come into their classrooms and registration will open at 8:45am. There will no longer be a need to line up on the playground and wait for the teachers to collect them. There will be members of staff on the doors to welcome the children. The gates onto the playground will be closed at 8:50am so any children who are not punctual will need to enter school via the school office where they will be recorded as late.

Gates and parking



You may remember that before Christmas, we asked for parents not to enter the school car park to drop children off at the start and end of the school day. This also includes children who are in Newchurch Robins at the start and end of the day. We agreed that parents dropping off at Newchurch Robins may drive into the school carpark between 7:30am and 8:00am, and then between 4:15pm and 5:30pm when collecting. This is when the staff carpark will be less crowded and space is available. Many thanks to those parents who have supported us with this.





























Unfortunately, we are still finding that some parents/carers and grandparents are coming into the school carpark to drop their children off, parking in places which are not safe and in some cases, driving at high speed. Therefore, we have taken the decision to close the school gates from 8:00am until 9:15am and from 3:00pm until 4:15pm. This to allow our children to safely arrive and be collected each day. Please be aware that we have a number of children who come into school earlier in the morning for additional tuition and some days we have over 60 children leaving after participating in after school clubs.

We only have a small carpark and this is for staff only. If you are a holder of a blue badge, please show this at the gate and entry will be allowed. If the gate is not manned, then please ring the school office and someone will come to open the gate for you. If you are a blue badge holder but you are accompanied by someone who is able bodied and can collect the children from the playground and drop off, please could we ask that you park outside the school gates as space is a premium. Please could you pass this on to any family members who pick your children up. Please do not be offended if we refuse entry to the staff carpark.

We hope you recognise that this request is to ensure the safety of our children. Young children can be very unpredictable and have varying awareness of risks so we need to mitigate any risks which could be presented to them.
