<b>What Lives Near Me?</b>	<p>Activity: Go on a short nature walk with an adult.</p> <p>Task: Collect or draw 3 things you find that are living (e.g. a flower, a bug, a bird).</p> <p>Bring in: A drawing or photo of what you found.</p>	
<b>Animal Movements Game</b>	<p>Activity: Learn about different animals and how they move.</p> <p>Task: Pretend to move like animals:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Slither like a snake</li><li>• Hop like a frog</li><li>• Fly like a butterfly</li></ul> <p>Bring in: A picture of your favourite animal or a video of your animal dance.</p>	
<b>Minibeast Hunt</b>	<p>Activity: Look under logs, leaves, or in the garden with a grown-up.</p> <p>Task: Find some tiny creatures (bugs, worms, spiders).</p> <p>Bring in: A picture, drawing, or bug ID card (with help).</p>	
<b>Make a Bug or Bird Feeder</b>	<p>Activity: Make a simple bug hotel or bird feeder with an adult.</p> <p>Ideas:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Pinecone feeder (peanut butter + seeds)</li><li>• Plastic bottle feeder</li><li>• Pile of sticks for insects</li></ul> <p>Bring in: A photo or drawing of what you made.</p>	
<b>Nature Art</b>	<p>Activity: Collect leaves, petals, sticks or stones.</p> <p>Task: Use them to make a nature picture or collage at home.</p> <p>Bring in: Your finished artwork to show and tell.</p>	
<b>My Favourite Wild Thing!</b>	<p>Activity: Think about all the animals and plants you've seen or learned about.</p> <p>Task: Choose your favourite and make a crown, mask, or puppet of it.</p> <p>Bring in: Your creation and tell us why you chose it!</p>
