## Dates for Christmas Fair Donations / Dress Down Days

## What to do?

Each year group is asked to organise a stall at the school's Christmas fair. They are asked to collect donations from school/purchase the items for their stall, set it up on the afternoon and arrange for the stall to be manned throughout the evening of the fair. Any monies will be repaid on delivery of receipts, please check with PTA before purchases are made, as some items may already be available. Also bear in mind, this money is for the children, so expenses should be kept as low as possible.

#### **School Donation Stalls**

On the run up to the Christmas Fair, dates are assigned as Donation Dates. This means that the whole school is asked if they are able to make a donation of a particular item to be used on a stall. All donations are taken into school on the morning of the donation date by the children. The responsible year group then collects the donations from each classroom by 9:10am, and stores the items until the fair on 6<sup>th</sup> December. In return for the donation the children are allowed to wear their own clothes for the day (Dress Down Day) on the day of donations.

### What happens on the day of the Christmas Fair?

The year groups are asked to bring the items into school after 3.30pm on the 6<sup>th</sup> December, Christmas Fair Day and set up their stall ready for the start of the Christmas Fair. Each Year Group parents are asked to man their stall throughout the evening. Some choose to run a rota then everyone can enjoy the evening.

Craft Stall	Year 4	Create a craft stall of your choice with a Christmas theme, previous stalls have made Christmas cards, tree decorations etc.
Christmas Kitchen	Year 5	Serve Christmas delights such as Mulled Wine, Hot Chocolate with marshmallows, Mince pies, waffles.
