## **Parent Governor Election**

We have a vacancy for a parent to join our governing board; anyone eligible is invited to consider standing for election as a parent governor, or nominating another parent to do so.

## The role of the governing board

The governing body, with the head teacher, has overall responsibility for the running of the school. Governing bodies have three core strategic functions:

- Ensuring clarity of vision, ethos and strategic direction.
- Holding the head teacher to account for the educational performance of the school and its pupils.
- Overseeing the financial performance of the school and making sure its money is well spent.

## The role of a parent governor

As a parent governor, you will work with the board to make sure it effectively carries out the duties referred to above. You'll also play a vital role in bringing a parental perspective to the governing board, but you are not there to speak 'on behalf' of the parent body.

To be a parent governor you should have:

- A keen interest in the school
- A strong commitment to the role and to improve outcomes for children
- Good interpersonal-skills, curiosity and a willingness to learn and develop new skills

The role of a parent governor is a very rewarding one, but it does require your commitment to carry out your responsibilities effectively. Your attendance at 3 to 4 meetings a term is expected (these are usually from 4:30 to 6:30pm; preparation for these will include reviewing policies, data and briefing notes). We also link our governors to a particular class and to a particular subject, with the expectation that you will meet with relevant staff to review and support progress as required.

Training is available for all governors.
